



November 5, 2005 - Kalamazoo College at Adrian College

ADRIAN - The Kalamazoo College football team lost 42-10 at Adrian in the Hornets' final road game of the year. Kalamazoo plays its final home game next Saturday against Tri-State.

Adrian opened its scoring with field goals at the 10 minute and two-minute marks in the first quarter. They followed with three touchdowns to take a 28-0 lead. Kalamazoo's Gavin Mooney kicked a 42-yard field goal just before halftime.

Adrian followed with two scores in the third quarter, and the Hornets got on the board again when Troy'e White connected with Randy Rzeknik on a six-yard scoring pass with 5:01 left in the game.

Mike Benson rushed for 48 yards on 14 carries to lead the Hornets. Troy'e White had 32 yards on four carries.

Tim Kaselitz was 16-of-29 passing for 78 yards and two interceptions. White was 4-of-8 for 33 yards and a touchdown.

Randy Rzeknik had five catches for 46 yards and a score. Jeff Green had five catches for 33 yards.

Adrian's Chris Clay rushed for 122 yards on 23 carries with a score. Randy Hutchison was 12-of-19 passing for 202 yards with four touchdowns and an interception.

Nick Toboy led the Hornet defense with 15 total tackles. Alex Leonowicz had 11 and Blake MacDonald finished with 10. Chris Werme had an interception and Dave Kelly had a quarterback sack.

Adrian's Taz Wallace had 15 total tackles.
