



September 17, 2005 - Kalamazoo College at Mount St. Joseph

CINCINNATI, Ohio - The Kalamazoo College football suffered a 42-0 loss at the College of Mount St. Joseph on Saturday.

The Lions scored their first touchdown on a six-yard run with 10:52 left in the first quarter. Mount St. Joseph led 21-0 at halftime.

The Hornets were held to 232 yards of total offense (52 rush, 180 pass) while Mount St. Joseph accumulated 425 yards (238 rush, 187 pass). The Hornets turned the ball over twice to the Lions' one turnover, and Mount St. Joseph held a 10 minute advantage (35-25) in time of possession.

Quarterback Tim Kaselitz was the leading rusher for the Hornets with 51 yards on 10 carries. Kaselitz was 19-of-36 passing for 180 yards with two interceptions.

Jeff Green had eight catches for 94 yards. Mike Leifeld had six catches for 58 yards.

Ryan Ouillette led the Kalamazoo defense with 13 total tackles and an interception. Chris Werme had 12 tackles with four pass break-ups. Alex Leonowicz also had 12 tackles. Nick Toboy had seven tackles along with a 64-yard kickoff return.

Mike Lovell led the Lions with 133 yards rushing on 17 carries with three touchdowns. Rashon Lewis was 8-of-18 passing for 70 yards. Andy Wellendorf had seven catches for 88 yards.

Kalamazoo will play its home opener next Saturday, Sept. 24 against Kenyon College at 1 p.m.
