



September 10, 2005 - Kalamazoo College at Wabash College

CRAWFORDSVILLE, Ind. - When the Kalamazoo College football team scored on just its second possession, the Hornets seemed to awaken a sleeping giant. Wabash responded with 46 unanswered points en route to a 46-6 win in the season opener for both teams.

Kalamazoo's Tim Kaselitz hit Stan Peplinski on a nine-yard touchdown pass with 11:08 left in the first quarter (extra-point missed) to give the Hornets a 6-0 lead. Wabash, having thrown an interception on its first possession to set up the Hornet score, responded with a six-play, 75-yard drive of its out capped off by a 55-yard touchdown run by Don Juan Brown to take a 7-6 lead. The Little Giants never looked back.

Wabash scored again with 52 seconds left in the first quarter to take a 14-6 lead. A nine-point second quarter gave Wabash a 23-6 advantage at halftime. Wabash equaled its 23 first-half points in the second half to generate the 46-6 final.

Wabash amassed 582 yards of total offense while holding Kalamazoo to just 118 yards.

Mike Strong rushed for 37 yards on nine carries to lead Kalamazoo. Mike Benson had 25 yards on 13 carries.

Tim Kaselitz was 14-of-20 passing for 118 yards with one touchdown and no interceptions.

Jeff Green had four catches for 39 yards while Mike Leifeld had four catches for 31 yards.

Don Juan Brown led Wabash with 133 rushing yards on 19 carries with one touchdown.

Russ Harbaugh was 23-of-31 passing for 329 yards with three touchdowns and an interception. Kyl Piazza had six catches for 62 yards. Ray Green had three catches for 77 yards.

Blake MacDonald led the Hornet defense with 13 total tackles. Dave Kelly had 11 tackles. Rob Atwood had a 29-yard interception return to set up the Hornets' only touchdown.
