RE: Progress Report in Connection with Programs Associated
with Black Students

DATE: July 16, 1969

I should like to announce the following developments:

1. Mr. Philip M. Jackson has been appointed to the Calder Chair of Urban Sociology . He will begin his duties on August 1, 1969.

Negotiations are continuing toward the end of appointing other Black faculty members.
2. Work is under way with respect to increasing our course offerings in areas of particular interest to Black students.
3. Mr. Hank Harper has begun his duties as a half-time recruiter in the Admissions Office. He will work during the summer months. In the Fall another half-time Black recruiter will be retained and Mr. Harper will take up duties in the Physical Education Department.
4. Dr. Romeo Phillips has been appointed as a member of the Campus Life Committee. The BSO has been invited to provide a Black student as a voting member of the Committee.
5. Bruce Kelly, a sophomore Black Student, has been appointed as a Floor Adviser effective the 1969 Fall Quarter.
6. Presently we are awaiting a reaction from the BSO prior to making the appointment of a half-time Black Counselor to work with students on personal and academic problems.
