These returning letter winners are Karen Glowacki, the high individual scorer with 499.3 average out of a possible 648 for four rounds and Nancy Covert, second high individual scorer with 497.7 average for four rounds.

Two members of the 1972-73 WMIAA runner-up team, Faye Tomaszewski and Karen Hunter, contribute fine shooting to make this one of the strongest teams the Hornets have ever had.
