"K" ARCHERY TEAM PLACES SECOND IN MIAA

The women archers of Kalamazoo College claimed second place in the Michigan Intercollegiate Athletic Association (MIAA) this season, losing their bid to repeat as league champions.

Kalamazoo took the runner-up spot in the league behind Alma College. Under the guidance of professional archer Ted Brooks, the Hornets posted a 5-3 season record and placed second in the MIAA tournament at Calvin College May 3-4.

Two Kalamazoo shooters were among the tournament's top six archers. Juniors Sue Shirey (Milan) and Judy Johnson (Bloomfield Hills) took the fourth and fifth berths. Both Shirey and Johnson were Kalamazoo College team leaders during the season. Other squad members who contributed to the Hornets' winning season were juniors Ann Long (Rochester) and Laura Franseen (Rochester), and freshmen Sharon Bosche (Bourbonnais, IL) and Laura Gran (Kalamazoo).
