



House. Placekicker Brad Horman was named to the All-MIAA Second Team.

The defense was led by several players who received All-MIAA recognition. Shoring up the line were All-MIAA defensive linemen Tom Siwajek and Tony Prey. Leading the linebacking corps was All-MIAA linebacker Bob Holloway. Linebackers Josh Howie and Andy Smetana received All-MIAA recognition, as did cornerback Bryan Schultz and safety Chad Zollman, both among league leaders in interceptions. All-MIAA cornerback Steve Bastian finished the season with 51 tackles, 13 broken up passes, and six interceptions. Safety Kenny Metcalfe led the secondary with 63 tackles.

## Head Coach Dave Warmack

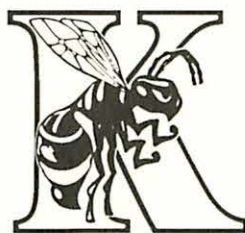
**Dave Warmack**, a native of Kalamazoo and a former Hornet football player, has completed his fourth season as head coach. Two years ago, Warmack guided Kalamazoo to its first winning record since 1983 and led the team to challenge seriously for an MIAA championship this season.

A 19-year coaching veteran who recorded a career high school record of 129-35, Warmack

coached at Grand Junction (Colorado) High School from 1984-89, leading teams to an overall record of 59-12. His 1988 Colorado state championship team was ranked 10th nationally by *USA Today*, and his 1989 squad defeated both the No. 1 and No. 2 ranked Colorado teams. Warmack's 1985 team was also a state finalist, while his 1984 and 1987 squads made it to the state semifinals.

Warmack has received a number of coaching honors, including Area and Regional Coach of the Year in Michigan (1978, 1979), Conference Coach of the Year in Colorado (1980, 1984, 1985, 1988), and 3-A Coach of the Year in Colorado in 1988. Warmack received a BS degree from Western Michigan University and earned an MA at Central Connecticut State University.

Warmack's assistant coaches are **Van Nickert** (offensive line), **Craig Blanchard** (defensive coordinator), **Tom Sullivan** (receivers), **Mike Hause** (linebackers), **Dave Sichterman** (defensive line), **Mark Blaesser** (running backs), and **Steve Sloan** (defensive ends).

## About Football At 'K'

The 1993 Kalamazoo College squad enjoyed the most successful Hornet football season in 31 years. Kalamazoo registered a 7-2 record in 1993, more victories than any "K" team since the 1962 Hornets were 8-0. The team narrowly missed being considered for the NCAA Division III National Playoffs, taking second place in the tough Michigan Intercollegiate Athletic Association with a 4-1 conference mark.

New team records were set for passing offense (1,900 yards) and total offense (3,272 yards) during the 1993 campaign. Quarterback Chris Berkimer set five new school records: career passing (4,516 yards), career total offense (4,178 yards), single season passing (1,825 yards), single season total offense (1,750 yards), and single game passing (305 yards). Berkimer was the MIAA's top passer in 1993 with an efficiency rating of 118.66, completing 74 of 152 passes for 977 yards and 11 touchdowns in five league contests. He was also named to the All-MIAA First Team offensive squad.

Among Berkimer's favorite targets was wide receiver Dave Sherwood, who also set a new Hornet record when he caught nine passes for a single-game record 203 yards. Sherwood led the MIAA in pass receiving yardage, making 23 grabs for 434 yards (86.8 yards per game average) and six touchdowns in five games. Sherwood was second in the league in all-purpose yardage, averaging 130.8 yards per game, and was also named to the All-MIAA First Team. He finished the season with 578 total receiving yards and 1,003 all-purpose yards. All-MIAA Second Team receiver J.D. Wagner finished with 304 receiving yards. All-MIAA First Team tight end Aaron Ward recorded 459 yards receiving and three touchdowns.

Others major contributors on offense included All-MIAA First Team running back Clint Wagner, All-MIAA Honorable Mention fullback Mike Herron, and running back Seth Simpson. Bolstering a strong offensive line were All-MIAA picks Scott Boos and Scott French, as well as Jason Morgan, John Morgan, and Ron
