To the Committee on the Herald  
through this Committee the Convention

I propose to purchase the  
Convention's interests in the Herald.

I will give \$5,000.00 cash in hand  
the 1<sup>st</sup> of Jan next on in (\$5) <sup>(10)</sup> per  
annual payments at a rate of <sup>10</sup> per  
cent on the unpaid balance.

Granting the Convention the privilege  
of selecting the Editor for a limited  
term of years. Should it ever cease  
to be a Baptist Journal or organ  
there may be a provision in the bill of  
sale reverting it back to the Con-  
vention.

As if the Convention prefer it  
I will take the ~~Herald~~ Publish-  
ing department of the Herald on the  
same terms as the prior or present  
publisher for (\$5) <sup>(10)</sup> per year or  
an indefinite period
