To the Committee on the Herald + through this Committee the Convention

I propose to purchase the Convention's interest in the Herald. I will give \$500.00 cash in hand the 1st of Jan[uary] next or (5) five annual payments at a rate of ^ (10) ten percent on the unpaid ballance.

Granting the Convention the privilege of selecting the Editor for a limited term of years. Should it ever cease to be a Baptist journal or organ there may be proviso in the bill of sale reverting it back to the Convention.

Or if the Convention prefer it I will take the ~~Herald~~ publishing department of the Herald on the same terms as the prior or present publisher for (5) five or (10) ten years or an indefinite period
