NEW HEAD COACH TRAINS KALAMAZOO COLLEGE WRESTLING SQUAD

Terry St. Louis has taken over the reins of the Kalamazoo College wrestling team in its 1981 search for a second consecutive MIAA league title. St. Louis served as assistant coach under Carl Latora last season. Previously, he coached the grappling squads at Comstock and Portage Central High Schools and Hillside Junior High School.

St. Louis currently wrestles freestyle and has participated in open, olympic-style wrestling since 1974. He placed fifth at the U.S. Wrestling Federation National Tournament in 1979, and sixth in 1980. St. Louis also wrestled at Delton and Portage Central High Schools. He was a letterwinner in wrestling and soccer at Spring Arbor College.

St. Louis has played semi-pro football with the Kalamazoo All-Stars and is an avid paddleball and racquetball enthusiast. He is a printing salesman for Industrial Graphics Service of Kalamazoo.

Former head wrestling coach Carl Latora is still active in the Kalamazoo College sports program as wrestling coordinator and continues to work with individual grapplers on the Hornet squad.

The wrestling team has placed second at both the Hope Invitational and the Elmhurst Tournaments this season. The squad also earned resounding victories over Grand Rapids Bible and Grand Rapids Baptist. This year's only loss so far has been a close contest against Adrian.
