Coach Tish Loveless

Tish Loveless--professor of physical education; tennis and director of women's intercollegiate sports.

Ms. Tish Loveless has coached the women's tennis team for 20 years (taking 17 WMIAA titles) and the field hockey team for 16 seasons. She is a member of the United States Lawn Tennis Association and the United States Field Hockey Association. Ms. Loveless did her undergraduate work at the University of Illinois and received a M.S. degree from the University of California at Los Angeles. She will serve as director, for the second year, of the National Women's Collegiate Tennis Championships to be held at Kalamazoo College in June. She is a member of the USLTA Women's Collegiate Championship Committee.

Since 1936, Kalamazoo College tennis teams have ruled the courts in Michigan Intercollegiate Athletic Association play--and 1974 proved no different.

Coach Tish Loveless, coach of the women's tennis team and 1974's WMIAA tennis champions, is bringing back a squad of girls seeking to capture their 18th WMIAA title in the last 21 years. With six returning letter winners and some promising young freshmen, the outlook is bright.

Finishing with an overall 26-3 win-loss record, senior Marjorie Snyder is looked to for another fine year. Last year, Marjorie took the WMIAA singles title. Other returning letter winners are junior Lisa Culp, winner of the WMIAA No.3 singles title and a 17-2 overall record; Jane Pinkerman, sophomore, who won No.4 singles title in 1974 and has overall record of 9-3; returning senior, Jo Copeland and Jere Brooks, sophomore, 1974 WMIAA No.2 doubles winner. Coach Loveless is hoping for production out of two promising freshmen, Jane Belser and Vlenaetha McCaslin.

The tennis team is optimistically looking forward to another WMIAA tennis title and non-conference matches with Michigan, Ohio State, Indiana, and Big Ten Champions Michigan State.
